POSITION 1

Cradling Position

It is critical to ensure you always support a newborn baby's head. The Combi Magical Compact Carrier sets a new standard by offering your precious and fragile baby the ultimate level of comfort and head support.

Newborn (3.4kgs) to 7.4kgs
(or when the baby can support their head)

- 1 Lay the carrier on a safe, flat surface and place baby onto the cradling sheet with head to the very top of the cradling sheet.



- 2 Fasten the safety buckle and adjust so it is firm yet comfortable.



- 3 Place one arm and then your head through both shoulder straps. (Opposite arm to baby's head position.) While supporting the baby with both hands (as shown below) slowly stand up and make any final adjustments.



Fitment Tips

The one-touch buckle should not be connected in this position. When fitted, the shoulder strap furthest from you should be longer than the one closest to you. The bottom of the carrier should sit level with your belly button. Shoulder straps should sit on the middle of your shoulder. If they are pressing against your neck they need to be lengthened further.

POSITION 2

Face-in Cuddle

When the baby can support its own head it is now safe and comfortable to carry the baby in an upright position.

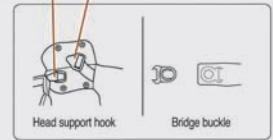

- 1** Fit the carrier by passing your arms through the arm holes, fasten the one-touch buckle behind your head/back and then tighten the waist straps.



- 2** Unfasten head support hook(s) and place baby into the carrier.



Release the left and right head support hooks.

- 3** Reattach head support hooks then secure the bridge buckle.
